**Integrated Health Care Services**  
**Developmental Disabilities**

Developmental Disabilities Director Cindy Doyle, along with IHCS Director Guse, continued the discussion of contracting out direct services for developmental disabilities clients, noting Doyle will continue to be involved with the program through the first year of transition to provide continuity to clients.

Guse and Doyle were directed to prepare a draft document for a contracted service provider to administer developmental disabilities services to Adams County clients and forward to Prosecutor Flyckt for review prior to presenting for Board approval.

**Public Health**

Commissioner Hartwig moved, Thompson seconded, to *authorize the Chairman to sign Agreement No. 800-812-1289, Amendment No. 2, between Spokane Regional Health District and Adams County for the period January 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 in the amount of \$2,000 for a total grant award of \$8,000. Motion carried.* (Support participation of Adams County staff in Foundational Public Health Services Cross Jurisdictional Sharing in Demonstration Project to build Communicable Disease/STD's Epidemiology and Community Assessment Capacity; dollars are for staff to attend training events and workshops.)

## **Environmental Health**

The temporary worker housing permitting process was discussed.

Additionally present were Prosecutor Flyckt; Environmental Health Director Taff; Building and Planning Director Wiltse and IHCS Director Guse.

Currently, temporary worker housing projects are applied for and permitted through Washington State Department of Health. However, several projects have requested septic systems permits for the projects through Adams County. Director Wiltse maintains that when the state begins the permitting process, the state should be the permitting entity through the life of the project.

Directors Wiltse and Taff will draft a letter, for Board approval, expressing the county's intent to defer permitting operations, relating to temporary working housing applications, to the Department of Health in accordance with RCW 70.114A.
