INSTRUCTIONS FOR OBTAINING AN OVERSIZE TRAVEL PERMIT

We require the following items in order to prepare a moving permit for county roadways.

1. A detailed turn-by-turn route with beginning and ending addresses within Adams County.
2. The maximum width and height.
3. The combined gross and legal weight of the hauling vehicle and the load.
4. The license plate number or VIN number of the power unit and trailing unit(s) as well as number of axles for power unit and trailing unit(s).
5. Sketch of vehicle, including axle spacings (feet) and actual load per axle (pounds).
6. Completed Moving Permit Application (next page).

The permit may take up to 24 hours; please plan accordingly and submit your information in a timely manner.

Permits submitted on Thursday or Friday, April-October, may require additional time.
