

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

Regular Meeting Adams County Services Building, Othello

May 10, 2000

The regular meeting of the Adams County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Bill Wills on Wednesday, May 10, 2000, at 9:00 a.m. in Othello. Commissioner Jeffrey W. Stevens and Commissioner W. L. Schlagel were present.

Judge Charlotte DuBois inquired about hiring temporary part-time office staff to cover during maternity leave of a current employee. Following discussion the board by consensus authorized the hiring of a temporary employee (four months maximum unless extenuating circumstances are presented to the board) at seven (7) hours per day at R6S1. This time period will allow for training up to one month.

Adams County Fair President Skip Hall and Fair Board member Terry Thompson discussed the financial status of the fair operation. A current loan, if any, will be verified with the Auditor. The Auditor will be requested to schedule a summer budget workshop date with approximately three (3) of the fair board members to assist with 2001 fair budget preparations that should facilitate a preliminary budget being filed by the mid-August deadline.

There being no further business to come before the board the meeting adjourned at 10:45 a.m.
