

# **COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS**

## **Regular Meeting Adams County Services Building, Othello**

**September 13, 2000**

The regular meeting of the Adams County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman Bill Wills on Wednesday, September 13, 2000, at 9:00 a.m. in Othello. Commissioner Jeffrey W. Stevens and Commissioner W. L. Schlagel were present.

Planner Dave Anderson addressed the board regarding the naming and signage of certain private roads following the recent amendment to Ordinance O-2-95. Costs associated with making the signs as well as installation and regular maintenance were discussed. The Board by consensus determined that the county should handle these costs. Any future private roads that qualify for signage will be the responsibility of the resident. This matter was further discussed after the arrival of Public Works Director O'Brien and Gale Kulm.

The memo from Director Caputo dated September 7, 2000, setting forth concerns and questions of the Adams County Planning Commission regarding planning sessions for rezoning the county were discussed. Clarification on some points was given by Planner Anderson emphasizing that basically the Planning Commission membership wanted the reassurance of the Board of Commissioners that they would be active participants in the process. A "Public Participation Questionnaire" was given each of the commissioners with a request to complete and submit to the department.

There being no further business to come before the board the meeting adjourned at 10:30 a.m.
