**Adams County Fair**

President Skip Hall and Treasurer Charlette Johnson presented the State Fair Evaluation report on the local fair; noted expiring board positions including the resignation of Shelby and relocation of Margaret Johnson. A recommendation was made to seek Hispanic interest in filling some of these positions. The Liquor Control Board has clarified new rules for rental groups wishing to consume liquor on the premises. Rental booking rates remain high.

**Community Counseling Services Contracts**

Commissioner Stevens moved, Schlagel seconded, to *authorize the chairman to sign the NCWRSN Amendment #3 that provides for services to individuals under the Involuntary Treatment Act and follows individuals under a court ordered least restrictive alternative.* Motion carried.

Commissioner Schlagel moved, Stevens seconded, to *authorize the chairman to sign the subcontract with Adams County Resource Center for Therapeutic Sexual Assault Services for the period 7/1/00 through 6/30/01.* Motion carried.

**MIS/Administrative Services Director for Community Counseling Services**

Commissioner Schlagel moved, Stevens seconded, to *authorize a new position - Management Information Services/Administrative Services Director within the Community Counseling Services Department.* Motion carried.

Total number of staff within the department will not change, duties of other staff will be shifted and consolidated. Director Brueske is expected to promote from within the department to fill the position that will be classified under the RSN pay schedule.

**Rezone/Comprehensive Plan**

A public input "workshop" session with the Board of Commissioners was set for Monday, November 27, 2000, from 11:00 a.m. until 12:00. An information update and discussion is scheduled with no decisions being mandated on this date. Formal public hearings will be set in the near future.

**Planning Commission**

The Commission is scheduled to hear two matters during a public hearing on November 16, 2000, in Ritzville: an unclassified use permit application and a rezone application.
