President Skip Hall reported that the Columbia Basin Herald will print the Fair Premium books for 2001.

Estimate by Gilbert Cabinet for repair on the 4-H Exhibit Building roof was estimated at \$7,992.00. Additional vendors contacted did not submit a bid. The board by consensus authorized the Fair to proceed with repairs recognizing that additional damage may be found once repairs are begun. Hall was requested to get pictures so a claim could be submitted to insurance.

A request was made for the Board of Commissioners to contact all Fair Board members by letter notifying them that proceedings of the Fair Board meetings are governed by State law and all practices and financial transactions are subject to State Audit. Board agreed to send notification.

**Emergency Management #EM010503**

Commissioner Johnson moved, Stevens seconded, to *authorize the Chairman to sign Contract #EM010503 between Adams County and the Military Department Emergency Management Division of the State of Washington in the amount of \$14,500 to provide pass-thru dollars (FFY02) for the county radiological emergency preparedness program relating to the Columbia Generating Station nuclear power plant.* Motion carried. Contract is effective July 1, 2001, through June 30, 2002.
