Community Counseling Services

Commissioner Johnson moved, Stevens seconded, to *authorize the Chairman to sign Amendment #1 to the contract between the NCWRSN and Adams County to provide enhanced crisis stabilization services to enrolled clients of DSHS Division of Developmental Disabilities on a 'fee for service' basis in the amount of \$3,400/year.* Motion carried.

The amendment also added some 'assessment' related language that had been inadvertently deleted from the original contract.

County Designated Mental Health Professional

Commissioner Johnson moved, Stevens seconded, to *appoint Patrice Dial, M.Ed. as a County Designated Mental Health Professional as outlined in RCW 71.05 effective immediately.* Motion carried.

Bench Road Speed Limit

Public Works Director O'Brien and Engineer Johns discussed traffic count and proposed speed limit change for Bench Road (Reynolds to SR24) to 40 m.p.h. Traffic count in excess of 1,000 vehicles/day (church, day care, truck traffic, urbanization) was cited as partial justification for the reduction.
