Chemical Dependency

Commissioner Johnson moved, Stevens seconded, to *authorize the Chairman to sign Department of Corrections Contract # COC05507 Amendment #1 which reflects a revision in the Statement of Work that now requires more detail to accompany billings.* Motion carried.

Legislative Forum

Counseling Director Brueske reported on confirmations received from legislators; inquired about additional invitations to be issued to social service agencies, and discussed the format and parameters of the forum including the need to have a moderator for the forum.

Building and Planning Department

Director Wiltse submitted a sample "Building Permit Guidelines" checklist for use by staff and the public when requesting a building permit. Approximately ninety-one (91) residences still require some modification of physical addresses.

Adams County Fair

Skip Hall and Merritt Johnson addressed Fair Board vacancies and made several recommendations of those who had expressed interest in serving. The Commissioners prior to formal appointment will contact these individuals.

Hall and Johnson reported that they had received verbal confirmation of a \$20,000 grant to construct a new horse facility at the fairgrounds. This grant represents approximately 20% of the total funds estimated for the project. Further details were requested prior to any decision being made by the Commissioners.

State surplus will be monitored for possible purchase of a “front end loader tractor” for use at the fairgrounds. The previous piece of equipment will be declared surplus for scrap/junk at a later date.
