#### Community Mobilization

Community Counseling Director Brueske reported that the department had been given a special commendation award and a check in the amount of \$2,500. The Community Mobilization Board will be given to the check and asked to determine distribution amounts for each of the programs.

#### Strengthening Families

Commissioner Johnson moved, Stevens seconded, to *authorize the Chairman to sign staffing approval for the following individuals to provide professional services for the second 2003 session:*

*Child Care @ \$12/hour: Ashley Bise*

*Program Coordination @ \$16/hour: Tim Taff*

#### Department of Corrections

Commissioner Stevens moved, Johnson seconded, to *authorize the Chairman to sign Amendment #2 to the Contract between Adams County Community Counseling and the Department of Corrections for the provision of chemical dependency treatment services to qualifying substance abuse incarcerated individuals after their release and while still doing community service. **Motion carried.*** This is a "fee for service" based contract.

**Department of Alcohol and Substance Abuse**

Commissioner Johnson moved, Stevens seconded, to *authorize the Chairman to sign Contract #0363-26854 Amendment #1 between Adams County Community Counseling and the Department of Alcohol and Substance Abuse that verifies funding in the amount of \$483,831 (an increase of \$32,696).* **Motion carried.**

**Washtucna School District**

Commissioner Johnson moved, Plager seconded, to *authorize the Chairman to sign the Community Mobilization Against Substance Abuse Contract between Adams County Community Counseling and the Washtucna School District for substance abuse prevention activities for the period September 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004 in the amount of \$300.* **Motion carried.**

**Adams County Health District**

Discussion was held related to the transition of the Health District to a Health Department and of that new department being under the direction of Kate Brueske. Staffing, name change, salary compensation, and 2004 budget were discussed.
