Building and Planning

Director Wiltse reported that the International Building Code goes into effect July 1, 2004 with non-code cities (Washtucna and Lind) required to comply since the State will adopt for those entities. Each town will, however, need to adopt a formal fee schedule that Wiltse and Inspector White will assist in developing.

Wiltse will draft a revised agreement between the County and Washtucna for the county's assistance with building and code review/inspections.

Discussion was held on establishing a permit tracking system between the county/health department/towns to assist with approval of specific phases of the permitting process. Central Services will be setting up a meeting between the departments responsible for this process to facilitate a discussion of requirements for such a tracking system.

Economic Development

Roger Krug provided an update on economic development planning for the Town of Washtucna.

Rodeo Lake

The Board by consensus authorized the disconnection of electrical service on the pump at Rodeo Lake.

Health Department Advisory Board

Director Brueske reported that Dr. Moody recommended establishment of a “focus group” format rather than a formal board that met on a regular basis. These groups would be primarily for dissemination of information and public awareness of certain public health issues. Brueske discussed the changes to be effective January, 2005, for food related businesses – restaurants, schools, grocery stores, deli’s, etc. – and the formation of a “focus group” to discuss these changes in advance of implementation.
