Local Issues

Jim Pitt, Bernadine Pherigo, and Dana Rios, Clerk of the Town of Hatton, discussed the following with the Board:

- Dogs running loose in the town, especially those being dropped off by people passing through – leash law and legal backup;
- Water issues due to the local drought and effect on deep wells and the aquifer;
- Street repair, paving – Engineer Johns explained that grant funds were available for developing a “plan” but not for doing the actual work – Johns will be alert for any construction fund program availability;
- Signs on Muse and Roxboro Roads – Stop and Yield signs
- Paths and Trails Fund – Engineer Johns will assist the Town in developing a plan to utilize some of these funds for a path

Department of Health
