**ORDER OF BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
ADAMS COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

IN THE MATTER OF LOAD RESTRICTIONS ON ADAMS COUNTY ROADS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT EMERGENCY RESTRICTIONS for vehicles on all Adams County Roads shall be imposed as deemed necessary after **January 4, 2006**, and continuing in full force and effect until **April 17, 2005**, and during the time as set forth above, the GROSS LOAD LIMITS shall be based on the table as set forth herein. During the period, restrictions may be intermittent depending on weather conditions and permission may be granted by the Road Department to waive loads in excess of those stated herein. When restrictions are removed for prolonged periods, restriction signs will be covered.
