#### **Economic Development**

Roger Krug reported on companies interested in re-locating to Adams County; reported that several clients had been referred to the Small Business Center in Moses Lake for assistance in developing business plans; presented the invoice procedure and project status report forms to be used by those given economic development project funding from the county; and, provided updates on the wind tower data collection as well as bio-diesel proposed projects.

#### **Storage Pond Proposal**

Building and Planning Director discussed the SEPA Checklist submitted by Cascade Earth Sciences on behalf of OB-3 Resource Management LLC for a Conditional Use Permit.

The CUP application is for a proposed storage pond is for a process water land treatment system in Ag Zoning. The revised documents reflect a move of the storage pond two miles east into the center of the Stahl Farm from the original location. The new location and proposed secondary containment are presented as a resolution to dam failure concerns expressed about the previous location by the Bureau and ECBID. The document presents a nuisance odor response and management plan.

The application will be processed by the Board of Adjustment and will include a public hearing period
