#### Prosecutor's Office

Prosecutor Flyckt reviewed staffing and caseload in his office and reported that the Attorney General's Office had provided a contact for him of someone who may be interested in doing part-time or contractual work handling specific types of cases.

Following discussion, **Board consensus authorized** Prosecutor Flyckt to proceed with contact and negotiations with first option being on a contractual basis rather than employee basis.

Flyckt discussed the number of misdemeanor filings in District Court and discussed consideration of the establishment of a probation department to monitor adult probation compliance perhaps in conjunction with other county probation services. No final decisions were reached on the matter.

The **Board by consensus authorized** Prosecutor Flyckt to proceed with the hiring of a law student or intern to help with traffic infraction cases.

Space needs were discussed and the Prosecutor proposed modifications to his office to accommodate additional staff. Commissioner Plager will speak with Public Works Director O'Brien to assist with those changes.

Prosecutor Flyckt noted that he was making modifications to the storage space for the Office of Support Enforcement and would be furnishing an office for his use while in Othello. The **Board by consensus authorized** the purchase of a new desk for the office area.

Flyckt requested clarification on the legal assistance promised toward the formation of an Economic Development non-profit organization; and, noted that his office was available to assist with legal matters relevant to personnel policy development.

Prosecutor Flyckt reported that WAPA had requested his more active participation in that organization and the Board of Commissioners encouraged his participation even though it meant additional travel and mileage costs to the Department.
