Incident Residential Burglary and Recovery of Stolen Property

On 07-23-2008 at 1129 the Adams County Sheriffs Office received a 911 call of a burglary at 571 Rayburn Road.

When deputies arrived the landlord of that property had two burglars at gunpoint. A third burglar had fled on foot. The landlord is retired California Highway Patrol Officer.

Deputies took Dulce A. Bustos, 21 year old female, Othello address and Eliseo Garcia-Chavez, 23 year old male, Pasco address into custody at the Rayburn Road address. The third suspect is a 14 year old female juvenile was found at a residence on Foley Road a short time later and taken into custody.

Adams County Detective developed information that lead to a search warrant that was served on a house at the 1600 block of Foley Road. This information also led to burglary cases in Franklin County. Franklin County Detectives assisted with the search warrant and also recovered stolen property in the Pasco area.

The search warrant on Foley Road resulted in the recovery of several thousand dollars of stolen property. The stolen property ranged from firearms, jewelry, and lawn care equipment. Bustos and Garcia-Chavez were booked into the Adams County Jail on one count of Residential Burglary. The juvenile was taken to Martin Hall in Medical Lake and booked on one count Residential Burglary. Additional charges are pending in Adams and Franklin County.
