

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

**Adams County Services Building, Othello
February 11, 1998**

The Adams County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, February 11, 1998, in Othello, with Chairman Schlagel and Commissioners Wills and Logan present.

Commissioner Wills moved, Logan seconded, to authorize the chairman to sign DASA Work Order 6414, Amendment #1 with the Division of Alcohol and Substance Abuse. Motion carried. This amendment updates language in the payment/billing code, subcontracting code, credentials and minimum requirements, and required audits between Adams County and DSHS.

Commissioner Logan moved, Wills seconded, to appoint Margaret Morris, M.S.W. as an Adams County Designated Mental Health Professional entitled to perform the civil duties of RCW 71.05. Motion carried.

City of Othello Councilmember Clemons reported that citizens are putting garbage in the recycle bins and this needs to be monitored in addition the bins for cardboard appear to always be full and additional units would be used if available.

Gene Oord and Jack Coulter on behalf of citizens residing in the vicinity of McKinney Road presented a petition requesting county intervention with the health and living conditions in the area. Planner Anderson had already investigated the situation and read the letter which was being sent to the area resident involved.

Adams County Fair Board President Skip Hall updated the board on fair business items and scheduled activities.

There being no further business to come before the board the meeting adjourned at 12:00 noon.
