

## COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

Adams County Services Building, Othello

October 14, 1998

The Adams County Commissioners met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, October 14, 1998, in Othello, with Vice-Chairman Wills and Commissioner Logan present. Chairman Schlagel was absent.

Community Counseling Services Director Kate Brueske gave a detailed update on grants written and received by the department, including a *Community Training Grant* with educational materials on display for review and hands-on exercises; a *Challenge Course Techniques Grant*; and grants for *D.A.R.E.*, *Team State Prevention Conference*; *Hey Kids Summer Program*; *Specialized Sexual Assault Prevention Program*; and, an *After School Program in conjunction with WSU*. Brueske noted that the department was in the process of applying for grant funds for *Domestic Violence Services and Emergency Shelter Services for Domestic Violence Victims*.

Commissioner Logan moved, Wills seconded, to authorize the Vice-Chairman to sign the Washington State Migrant Council contract for the ECEAP Program in the amount of \$747.50 for the period 10/01/98 through 5/15/99. Motion carried.

Commissioner Logan moved, Wills seconded, to authorize the Vice-Chairman to sign the Washington State Migrant Council contract for the Head Start Program in the amount of \$540.00 for the period 11/01/98 through 4/30/99. Motion carried.

Bob Lonn, Northwest Council of Governments & Associates Consultant/Planner updated the board on activities related to the salmon/dam removal issue and various other issues affecting the Pacific Northwest. NWCOG works within the county in conjunction with Big Bend Economic Development Council. A request was made and taken under consideration for renewal of funding for 1999.

Gene Mills, Othello resident, presented concerns he had with the recent ruling from the Building and Planning Department regarding his request for placement of a mobile home next to his house on his personal property. The board will discuss the matter with staff from Building and Planning and make any decisions necessary following that review.

Building and Planning Director Caputo gave a departmental report to the board.

There being no further business to come before the board the meeting adjourned at 11:30 a.m.
