

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
Regular Meeting
Adams County Services Building, Othello

April 13, 1999

The regular meeting of the Adams County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman W. L. Schlagel on Tuesday, April 13, 1999, due to scheduling conflicts on the regular Wednesday date, at 9:00 a.m. in Othello. Commissioner Bill Wills and Commissioner Jeffrey W. Stevens were present.

Warden Conservation District Supervisors John Preston, Robert Allison, Don Underhill, and Dale Pomeroy, along with Dave Koller met with the board to review the boundaries of the conservation districts specifically that of the Warden Conservation District; to discuss cost share programs, high school scholarship program, irrigation and water management programs, and, erecting signs to denote the boundary of the district; and, to respond to any questions from the board and public.

Recycling Coordinator Dixie Fultz discussed a proposal to allow "continuous free-dumping of yard waste year round". Discussion followed with the board taking the proposal under consideration.

Judge Charlotte DuBois went into executive session under RCW 42.30.110(g) from 10:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m.

Following executive session, the board agreed to allow for a full-time job shared position within the Othello District Court. As policies have previously been established to address job-shared positions Judge DuBois will work with the Auditor's Office to finalize specific details.

Planner Dave Anderson responded to questions from the Board regarding the proposal received earlier from the Task Force relating to zone/code changes that would affect development outside the "Planning Area and Within the Panhandle".

Chairman Schlagel left for another meeting at 11:00 a.m. Vice-Chair Wills presided during the balance of the meeting.

There being no further business to come before the board the meeting adjourned at 11:15 a.m.
