

# COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

## Adams County Courthouse, Ritzville July 12, 1999

The regular meeting of the Adams County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman W. L. Schlagel on Monday, July 12, 1999, at 8:30 a.m. in Ritzville. Commissioner Bill Wills and Commissioner Jeffrey W. Stevens were present.

Public Works Director Long reported on road maintenance issues and noted that the road crew worked late July 8 on the Lind-Warden Road with some approaches remaining to be finished and with a second coat of oil to be applied during the coming week.

The board went into executive session with Risk Pool Manager Long under RCW 42.30.110(i) from 10:12 a.m. until 10:25 a.m.

It being the time of 11:00 a.m. and the place set for the opening of bids for the official county newspaper, bids were opened from:

Commissioner Wills moved, Stevens seconded, to accept the bid from the Ritzville Adams County Journal for official newspaper at \$5.25 per column inch effective July 1, 1999, through June 30, 2000. Motion carried.

Judge Miller and Juvenile Administrator Gowan reviewed the 1999 Juvenile budget and statistics.
