

# COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

## Adams County Courthouse, Ritzville November 10, 1999

The regular meeting of the Adams County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Chairman W. L. Schlagel on Wednesday, November 10, 1999, at 9:00 a.m. in Othello. Commissioner Bill Wills and Commissioner Jeffrey W Stevens were present.

Commissioner Stevens moved, Wills seconded, to authorize the chairman to sign the Community Counseling Services/D.A.R.E. Contract with the City of Othello Police Department. Motion carried.

Les Clemons, Othello, reported on the progress of the Heritage Corridor Project and noted that staff will be conducting an informational meeting on November 17, 1999, at 2:00 p.m. in the Columbia Basin Irrigation District boardroom.

Jeanie Ochoa and members of the Adams County Park and Recreation District #1 met with the board to inform them that they were currently ranked #1 for the YAF Grant proposal submitted. A Cooperative Agreement draft, which will be required if the grant is awarded to the District, was given the board for review. A letter requesting the 1999 budgetary allocation from Fund #122 was given the Commissioners.

Juvenile Administrator Gowan and Probation Officer Garza met with the board to review the preliminary 2000 budget for the department.

Daryl Akkerman (part owner) and Len Akkerman (manager) discussed problems with the operation and upkeep of the Westwind Apartments located on Taylor Rd. in Othello. Inquiry was made regarding Health District intervention due to the sanitation and safety concerns at the facility. Dave Anderson responded to questions regarding a proposed subdivision by Eagle Properties (part owners of the facility).

There being no further business to come before the board the meeting adjourned at 12:00 noon.
