Criminal Justice Treatment Account

Integrated Health Care Services Director Guse reported Adams County will need to indicate a desire to administer Criminal Justice Treatment Account (CJTA) funding directly or have the funding administered through the Spokane County BHO/ASO. Adams County is appropriated \$43,461.00 for criminal justice treatment in 2019.

An explanation of how assessments are handled and the determination made for CJTA funding was provided. Currently, the county provides treatment and is reimbursed those costs.

Director Guse will prepare a letter electing to defer the Criminal Justice Treatment Account funding allocation to the current agreement and continue to contract with Spokane County BHO/ASO for CJTA services.

Adams County Pet Rescue

Roger Thieme provided an overview of Adams County Pet Rescue activities. Additionally present were Joe Rangel; Trudy Doolittle; Kyya Grant; Ernie Sommers; Myra Walter; and, Randy Deasy.

Mr. Thieme reviewed the donation process and facility improvements as a result of donations. While appreciative of the county's annual allocation to Pet Rescue, Mr. Thieme is requesting a contract between Adams County and Pet Rescue for funds based on the number of animals cared for outside of city limits.

Commissioner Hartwig expressed appreciation for the accomplishments of Pet Rescue and its contribution to Adams County.
