Integrated Health Care Services

Dr. Brzezny, Adams County Health Officer, recognized IHCS staff during National Nurses' Week. Treatment has concluded for a tuberculosis (TB) case in Adams County with Dr. Brzezny recognizing IHCS employees Martha Aguilar and Rebecca Koehn for their efforts in handling the case.

Dr. Brzezny reported on the recent mumps outbreak on the Grant County border noting vaccinations were provided with individuals isolated and treated. Efforts are being made to educate citizens on diseases such as hantavirus, spread by rodents; and West Nile virus, spread by mosquitos. Nitrate levels in private wells was discussed.

Karen Potts, RN, reported on participation in the Foundational Public Health Services Delivery Project in Spokane, participating in a T-Rex exercise to plan for a potential outbreak event. The goal of the project was to test new service delivery models to increase access to expertise and local knowledge, as well as increase the quality, consistency, and quantity of services provided through the service area.

Integrated Health Care Services Director Guse requested further review of the Qualifacts Agreement for the Behavioral Health EMR reporting system; as well as reviewing janitorial issues in her department.

Crisis Agreement 19-ASO2295

Commissioner Thompson moved, Hartwig seconded to *authorize the Chairman to sign Agreement No. 19-ASO2295, Amendment #2, with Spokane County, a political subdivision of the State of Washington, by and between the Spokane County Regional Behavioral Health (SCRBH), a*

division of Spokane County Community Services, Housing, and Community Development Department (CSHCD), (hereinafter "CSHCD SCRBH") and Contractor identified as Adams County Integrated Health Care Services for the period January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019.
