Booker Road and SR26 Intersection Safety Project (CRP-193)

Commissioner Weise moved, Thompson seconded, to *award the Booker Road and SR26 Intersection Safety Project (CRP-193) to the lowest responsible bidder, Central Washington Asphalt, Inc., for the bid amount of \$319,000 conditioned upon the Concurrence to Award received from WSDOT headquarters for the required six percent (6%) DBE Goal as part of the condition to award; and, approve the Chairman to sign the Concurrence to Award. Motion carried.* The bid is 68.6% of the engineer's estimate of \$464,869.80.

State Auditor

Audit Manager Brad White, along with staff Heather Peterson and Phillip Ventress, reported the findings of a review by the State Auditor's Office regarding a citizen concern involving the Adams County Sheriff's Office.

The following areas were examined:

1. sales of forfeited vehicles;
2. ownership and disposal of a of Kimber .380 weapon;
3. a forfeiture default order date prior to 45 day deadline;
4. a forfeiture hearing date change; and,
5. real estate seizures.

It was noted the citizen filing the complaint will receive a copy of the written review presented today directly from the state auditor's office.

Adams County Horticultural Pest and Disease Control Board

Commissioner Weise moved, Thompson seconded, to *reappoint Dale Beus, Othello; and, Kris Butcher, Othello; to the Adams County*

Horticultural Pest and Disease Control Board, each for a two (2) year term, effective May 1, 2021 through April 30, 2023. Motion carried.
