Emergency Management

Commissioner Hartwig moved, Stevens seconded, to *authorize the Chairman to sign Contract E13-006, plus the following forms – Debarment, W-9, and Signature Page - between the Washington State Military Department and the Energy Facility Site Evaluation Council (EFSEC) effective June 30, 2012 through June 30, 2013 in the amount of \$27,000 to be used for salaries, equipment, office expenses, travel, training and exercises.* **Motion carried.**

Jay Weise reported that State representatives assisted with the preparation of the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan and pending receipt of some follow-up responses, the Plan will be ready to submit to the State.

Weise reported on the recent REC Silicon facility release originating in Moses Lake. Information on the incident was difficult to obtain and the lack of information caused some concern from local citizens.

The radio project continues to move forward with parties having recently resolved some customer service issues.

Emergency Assistance

Othello Emergency Assistance Coordinator Dan Leary requested additional funding for the year since FEMA funding was eliminated. This funding is used for housing, utility, and food for individual and family

emergencies. The Board **by consensus authorized \$5,000 in additional funding from Fund #123.** The Ritzville Emergency Assistance was **authorized an additional \$2,500.**

Food Handler Cards

IHCS Director Brueske reported that 137 food handler cards had been issued as a result of the on-line classes (compared to previous issues of 167 for in-classroom testing for the same time frame). Food workers are reporting a high satisfaction level with the new program availability.

Integrated Health Care Services

Brueske reported that the June 13 and 14, 2012, mental health licensing certification review ruled that the local program was “in full compliance and no further action was required” by the Department. Ratings given reflected all categories at 100 with one at 97.

Commissioner Stevens moved, Hartwig seconded, to *authorize the Chairman to sign the following contracts and documents as presented by Director Brueske:*

- *1/1/2012-12/31/2014 Consolidated Contract #C16875, Amendment #3 between Washington State Department of Health and Adams County in the amount of \$34,502 for a total contract of \$379,434 – amends statement of work for WIC Nutrition Program; 5930 Public Health Funding; Public Health Emergency Preparedness & Response; and Tobacco Prevention and Control Program*
- *Contract #1163-27285, Amendment #2 between Adams County and DSHS Division of Behavioral Health and Recovery – Chemical Dependency Services in the amount of \$19,500 for a total contract of \$544,964 – amends statement of work for Youth Outpatient Services*
- *Contract #1163-30133, Amendment #1 between Adams County and DSHS WorkFirst Children with Special Needs in the amount of \$2,000 for a total contract of \$4,000*
- *Contract #1263-53330 between Adams County and DSHS Department of Developmental Disabilities for the period 7/1/2012 through June 30, 2013 in the amount of \$100,554 – provides employment services to eligible residents*
- *Lease Agreement between Ritzville Motor Company and Adams County for a one year period beginning July 18, 2012 through July 17, 2013 in the amount of \$400/month for counseling office space*

- *Application for Community Mental Health Services License*
- *Disclosure of Ownership and Control Interest Statement with United Behavioral Health*
- *Participation Agreement with United Behavioral Health, Inc. Network Group and Adams County Community Counseling Services for services (Mental Health and Substance Abuse) to clients enrolled in the Healthy Options program*

Motion carried.

IHCS Department received notification that the Health Department had been awarded a \$20,000 grant for their “obesity project; and, that a letter of intent was being sent for a substance abuse prevention grant to augment the current program implemented by Edie Borgman.
