**Shoreline Management Plan**

Building and Planning Director Wiltse spoke regarding the State funding approved and now available to the County to mitigate costs associated with the required update of the Shoreline Management Plan. An informational brochure on land management software was provided and the options available to staff and the general public were discussed. Additional information will be made available in a few weeks regarding details for the Shoreline Management Plan update and the software purchase.

**Temporary Food Permits**

Stacy Cutter and Brent Stenson, Environmental Health Specialists, reviewed the temporary food permit process – application, fee payments, and on-site inspection process prior to issuing the permit. Details of the vendor education process along with details of how the inspection process is conducted and reported were shared. Photos of recent events in the Othello area were provided as part of the packet information.

**Integrated Health Care Services**

Commissioner Stevens moved, Marshall seconded, to *authorize the Chairman to sign the following contracts and agreements as presented by Vicki Guse, IHCS Director:*

- *Contract No. 1163-27285, Amendment #5 between Adams County and DSHS Division of Behavioral Health and Recovery-Chemical Dependency Services in the amount of \$109,909.00 for a total*

*contract of \$657,129.00 (Amendment provides for the agency to continue with Chemical Dependency Services in the following areas – SAPT Grant in Aid, State Grant in Aid, TANF Treatment Services, TXIX Federal Waiver for DL and Adatsa, and Criminal Justice Tax Account);*

- *Service Agreement between Integrated Health Care Services of Adams County and Public Health – Seattle /King County to provide medication services in the form of pre-packaged medications (Seattle/King County will act as the pharmacy provider for a 6 month pilot project in order to evaluate the feasibility of and development of a long term pharmaceutical delivery model for the future – a cost savings since Seattle/King County can order in bulk and repackage then for distribution);*
- *Contract No. 1363-78889 between DSHS Work First Children with Special Needs and Adams County with a maximum amount of \$2,000 on a fee for service basis (\$325 per evaluation and \$225 for follow up);*
- *Big Bend Community College Health Agency Affiliation Agreement for the provision of clinical experience for Big Bend Community College's Health Education Program for 2013-2015;*
- *Educational Services District #123 Agreement for the Department of Early Learning Infant Toddler Regional Systems and Services Project reflecting a decrease of \$2,500 for the period July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 since a child care provider was unavailable for the agency to provide direct service implementation.*
