**Environmental Health**

Environmental Health Director Brent Stenson reported that he has received numerous early season fly complaints. Stenson has been investigating the complaints and monitoring the area and has determined that Perfect Blend Fertilizer Plant is likely the primary contributor to the fly population explosion. Stenson presented a copy of a letter, dated 04/04/2014, he sent to the president of Perfect Blend Fertilizer requesting cooperation in resolving the fly complaints and putting measures in place to prevent this situation from reoccurring.

**Peer Support Specialist**

Director Guse presented the Peer Support Specialist Job Description to the Board and discussed a salary range dependent upon applicant qualifications. Further qualification and classification review is necessary prior to the Board taking action.

**Registered Dietitian Agreement**

Director Guse recommended the position of Registered Dietitian be classified on the Adams County non-union salary schedule at Range 15, Step 10. The position is not eligible for benefits. The Board called for a meeting to be scheduled with themselves, Gary Hunt, Human Resources; and Prosecutor Flyckt to re-evaluate the Registered Dietitian Agreement.

### **Emergency Management**

Commissioner Hartwig moved, Marshall seconded, to *approve and authorize the Chairman to sign Contract E14-152 between Adams County, Washington State Emergency Management Department and Spokane County for \$15,269 for the period of 09/01/2013 – 06/30/2015 plus additional documents related to the contract; earmarked for salaries.*

**Motion carried.**

Director Weise reported on an Emergency Management tour at the Hanford site on May 19, 2014. The tour will focus on the emergency management program and the hazards at Hanford that could require a response from Adams County. Weise reported that two participants are allowed from Adams County and invited a commissioner to attend with him. Commissioner Marshall stated that he would attend the tour with Weise.
