Historic County Courthouse Rehabilitation Program

Public Works Director O'Brien provided a narrative of a grant application through the Washington State Historic County Courthouse Rehabilitation Grant Program for the 2015-2017 biennium. The proposed project would remove the existing windows, replace them with new frames and glazing and will include caulking, millwork sills and casework as needed to match the original installation. The total budget for the project is \$335,720 with a County match of 25% (\$83,930) required. The Board authorized proceeding with the application.

Title VI Non-Discrimination Agreement
