Adams County Auditor

Auditor Hunt met with the Board to discuss accounting services for junior taxing districts currently being served by the Adams County Auditor's office. Under RCW 36.22.090 "A county auditor is required to issue warrants for districts that do not issue their own warrants. A county auditor should not charge for providing these minimum required services."

Auditor Hunt presented two options for accounting services for junior taxing districts as follows:

- Option One will be to provide minimum warrant service with no fee to the district without any additional auditing services other than performing payroll.
- Option Two will be to continue with the same services currently being provided and charge the districts based on an allocation plan in place for all funds/districts.

Auditor Hunt requested and received by consensus direction from the Board to offer junior taxing districts a choice of the above options. If Option One is chosen, the County will meet the requirements of RCW 36.22.090, however, the level of service will be adjusted accordingly dependent upon which option the districts choose to implement.
