The purpose of the public hearing is to review community development and housing needs, inform citizens of the availability of funds and eligible uses of the state Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and receive comments on proposed activities, particularly from lower income persons residing in the Adams County area.

Up to \$117,089 may be available to Adams County to fund CDBG public services and local microenterprise assistance programs; and public health, emergency response, or temporary housing facilities that address COVID-19 impacts. All CDBG funded activities must benefit low- and moderate-income persons or meet the CDBG urgent need national objective criteria.

An overview of the proposed activities will be available for review at www.co.adams.wa.us. Comments may also be submitted in writing to Clerk of the Board, 210 W. Broadway, Ritzville, Washington 99169 up to the time of hearing.

A Spanish interpreter will be available. Courthouse Room 202 is handicap accessible.
