

Congratulations on becoming a candidate!

Now What?

You have two deadlines approaching very quickly:

1. Friday, May 28, 4:30 pm. Candidate statements and photos for the online & printed voter guide are due no later than **4:30 pm on Friday, May 28**. There are no exceptions to this deadline.
2. Two weeks from the day you become a candidate. If you are a candidate for an office that requires PDC reporting, you may have to start filing reports right away: www.pdc.wa.gov

Voter Guide

Adams County has an online and printed voter guide for both the Primary and General Elections.

There is a limit of **300 words** (100 Bio and 200 Statement), and your statement and photo must be in our office no later than Friday, May 28, 2021, at 4:30 pm. Detailed rules can be found in the Voter Pamphlet Guidelines on the Adams County website, co.adams.wa.us/departments/elections_new2019/index.php

If you don't submit a statement, your name will be listed in the pamphlet with the verbiage "No statement submitted".
